The Ski Time Square Turnaround project aims to improve traffic flow and pedestrian safety. Along with traffic improvements and heated sidewalks, old sewer infrastructure will be replaced and upsized. MWW has secured the easements for the project. A small portion of the project will be finished this fall which includes replacing two deep manholes. The rest of the construction for the project will commence in 2024.

## Fish Creek Treatment Plant Facilities Master Plan Project

Mount Werner continues to work with Carollo Engineers on the planning, design and engineering of Phase 2B. The lime batching and carbon dioxide systems have been ordered and 90% drawings have been completed with construction scheduled to begin in May of 2024. Phase 2B is necessary per the Corrosion Control Study results and related to the CDPHE compliance order for Lead and Copper treatment. Moltz Construction, Inc. (Phase 2A Contractor) was chosen to perform the project.

## Winter Preparation

Winter weather is on its way. Take precautions to prevent your pipes and water meter from freezing:

- ◆ Turn-off water to outside spigots and drain water from valve to spigot.
- ◆ Insulate around or apply heat tape to vulnerable pipes and meters so they are adequately protected from the cold.
- ◆ Do not leave your garage door open during cold weather.
- ◆ In the event that a pipe or meter does burst, turn the water off at the inside shut-off valve and contact a licensed plumber immediately.

Thank you to everyone this summer for helping to conserve water and following the permanent watering schedule.
